Merit Requirements Checklist

The following merit requirements must be successfully completed for a boy to be awarded the official Royal Rangers green Global Missions merit award. Each requirement must be approved by the boy's Group Leader or his designee. Content relating to each requirement may be found in the "Learning about Global Missions" section of this Global Missions Merit Activity Guide.

#	Requirement	Leader's Initials
1.	Select an article from the Assemblies of God World Missions publication "Worldview" and complete the following. Free digital copies of Worldview magazine can be found online at AGWM.org. If your church is not affiliated with the Assemblies of God, use a missions publication of your choice. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Read the article and summarize the message by explaining the main points. Explain why you selected the article and why it was significant to you. 	
2.	Select a missionary and collect the following information. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Personal & family information such as a family or individual photo, marital status, number and ages of children, where they live, etc. Description of their ministry Number of years in service as a missionary 	
3.	Contact the missionary selected in requirement #2 to ask the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> What special prayer needs do you have that we can pray with you for? (Then pray for them every day for at least one week.) When did you first sense a burden in your heart for the ministry in which you serve? When did you sense God calling you to serve in this ministry? When did you first experience the opportunity to serve in this role? 	
4.	Present your findings from requirements 2 and 3 above in an oral report of at least 5 minutes in length or a written report of at least 500 words.	
5.	Participate in an activity to raise money for a specific missions project or program, either on your own, or as a group with others in your outpost, church, or family. Describe the project or program for which the money was raised.	
6.	Participate in a missions outreach event in your local community or a missions trip outside of your local community. Explain the objectives of the event and what it meant to you.	
7.	Explain the mission of each of the following programs and briefly describe the ways each one seeks to achieve its objectives.
